SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. **ANNOUNCEMENT:** Nepean MSC Ltd., hereafter called the “Promoter”, will conduct a dirt track meeting called the 2010 King of Nepean for solo & sidecar motorcycles with Junior & Senior Competitors plus Junior Demonstration at Nepean Raceway on Saturday 17th & Sunday 18th July, 2010. The King Of Nepean is the major event during the 51st Year of Nepean Raceway.
2. **JURISDICTION:** The above meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Ltd. (MNSW) who has issued the Motorcycling Australia (MA) Permit No. 10/20046 and is open to holders of current MA National Senior or Junior Competition Licences.
 - 2.1 The Meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport (GCRs), these Supplementary Regulations, the Bylaws of MNSW and any Final Instructions. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these Rules, Regulations, By-Laws and Instructions.
3. **ENTRIES:** Entries open forthwith and for inclusion in printed program close at midnight on 1/07/2010. Any entry accepted after this date will incur \$25 late entry fee.
 - 3.1 In case of postponement/abandonment of the meeting the Promoters may retain all or any part of the entry fee, if such retention is approved by MNSW.
 - 3.2 Only entries received on the official entry form with the correct fee will be accepted.
 - 3.3 All entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Promoter.
 - 3.4 **RIDERS WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING** will have all entry fees refunded if entry withdrawn by 5pm on the Friday before the event. (less cost of track admission tickets, if tickets already mailed out at time of withdrawing entry)
4. **INSURANCE**
 - 4.1 National Capital Benefits Scheme, which provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
 - 4.2 Personal Accident & Ambulance insurance is rider’s responsibility.
5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:** Provided by Southcare Medical & First Aid Services. Being 3 Paramedics/Rescue Medical Technicians and shall be in attendance from 9.30am to 4.30pm on both Saturday 17th & Sunday 18th July, 2010.
6. **ENTRY FEE:**

 - 6.1 Payments by cash, cheque, money orders, or credit cards are accepted (No Amex/Diners). Credit Card entries will incur an additional fee of \$4.
 - 6.2 Any fees for dishonoured cheques or credit cards will be the responsibility of the entrant.
 - 6.3 Cheques are payable to Nepean MSC.
7. **GATE ENTRY FEES:** Each competitor will receive 2 entry passes. Additional passes can be purchased before the event for \$10ea (Limit 10 per competitor). Anyone aged 16years or over without an entry pass will be charged at the gate, \$15 for Saturday & Sunday tickets.



8. CLASSES & PRIZE MONEY:

- 1) KING OF NEPEAN: Unlimited Senior Competitors on Solo Motorcycles.

15) Junior 125cc 2Stroke/250cc 4Stroke 13-15yrs 125cc 2 stroke / 250 4 stroke.
16) Nipper Demonstration – as per GCRs 12.17.1

9. AWARDS & PRIZE MONEY:

- 9.1 Senior Classes: Prize Money for Seniors Only referred to in section 8 plus Trophies for 1st, 2nd & 3rd. Total Prize Money \$3,100.
9.2 Junior Support Classes: Trophies for 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class.

10. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

- 10.1 Seven solo & four sidecar entries are required to constitute a class.
10.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class, the decision to run, cancel, combine or separate classes will be at the discretion of the Promoter.
10.3 The promoter reserves the right to accept or decline any entry and to seed combination rider/machine into any event.

11. RACE FORMAT:

- 11.1 Solos as per GCRs 20.9.2, 3, & 5.
11.2 Sidecars as per GCRs 20.9.6, 7 & 8.
11.3 Riders are eligible to ride up one class, as per list below:
2. 125s ride up in 3; 3. 250 2 stroke ride up in 12;
4. 250 4 stroke ride up in 5; 5. 450 ride up in 12;
6. Open ride up in 12; 7. Sliders ride up in 12;
10. Twins ride up in 12;
11. Ladies ride up in capacity class of their motorcycle.
11.4 Junior Support: A maximum of 12 entries (i.e. 1 grid) will be accepted into each Junior support class.
11.5 Nipper Demonstration – This is a non competition display for Nippers aged 4-7yrs. They will ride on a 200mtr circuit i.e. around the dam on part of the speedway circuit. It will be a staggered start & finished with the display of a red flag. No points, scores or times will be recorded for this display. At the end of the day all Nippers will receive a participation ribbon.

- 12. MACHINES & RIDERS: All motorcycles, equipment & protective clothing must be scrutineered before practice & comply with Current GCRs.

13.

RIDING NUMBERS:

- 13.1 Will be notified with final instructions.
13.2 Competitors will be allocated their MNSW registered riding number, or their preferred riding number at the discretion of the Promoter, if entry is received by 1 July 2010.
13.3 All numbers & plates on all machines must comply with the GCRs.

- 14. GRID POSITIONS: Start gates will be allocated by draw of peg. First in first to draw peg for all Heats. For Repechage & Finals start gates shall be selected by the competitor, with the highest point scorer selecting first & so on.

15. RIDERS BRIEFING:

- 15.1 Will be held prior to the commencement of qualifying/racing, it's compulsory, all competitors must attend.
15.2 All Competitors must Sign Riders Briefing Sheets to confirm attendance, if under 18 years must be signed by Parent/Guardian.
15.3 Failure to attend Riders Briefing may result in a penalty up to exclusion from the meeting.

- 16. DRUG and/or ALCOHOL TESTING: As per GCRs.

- 17. CODE OF CONDUCT: As per GCRs.

- 19. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION: The events will be held on the 750metres, dirt circuit in a race direction of anti clockwise, at Nepean Raceway.

- 20. RACE STARTS: All races will be from a clutch start controlled by gates that fall forward away from the competitor. Starter assistant will call riders for next event up to the start gates, then with raised spinning index finger will indicate to riders that they are in the hands of the starter, so get ready the gates will drop within the next 0-7.5 seconds.

21. RACING:

- 21.1 All competitors shall be give 1 practice session per class & practice sessions will be held over 5.5 laps.
21.2 All Heats & Repechages will be held over 5.5 laps, with Finals held over 6.5 laps.
21.3 There will be a maximum of 12 solo or 6 sidecars in each Heat or Final.
21.4 Electronic Timing will be used.
21.5 Scoring will be as per GCR 12.14
21.6 Race Finishes: will be signalled by a waved chequered flag.

- 22. NOISE: As per GCRs. 12.10.4.5.

23. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 23.1 Machine impounding / Examination / Eligibility are at the discretion of the Steward/Clerk of Course.
23.2 Fuel is NOT available at Nepean Raceway.
23.3 Juniors must present yellow folder containing log book at sign on.
23.4 Back protectors must be worn as per GCRs 20.1.1.2.4 or 5.
23.5 Environmental Protection mats must be used as per GCRs 20.5.0.3.
23.6 No person may wear open footwear in the paddock or pit area.
23.7 No person under 16yrs will be allowed in the Pit Area, with the exception of Juniors competitors.

- 23.8 KNOBBY TYRES: Knobby tyres are NOT permitted on the rear wheel of any motorcycle at Nepean, with the exception of Juniors Up to 85cc 2 Stroke & 150cc 4 stroke.

 HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting") or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

DEFINITIONS

2. In this declaration:
- a) "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
 - b) "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
 - c) "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
 - d) "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
 - e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
 - f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

3. I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
- a) motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
 - i) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - ii) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
 - iii) that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
 - iv) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
 - vi) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
 - vii) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - viii) that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
 - b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
 - c) to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
 - d) have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

4. Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:

- rendered with due care and skill;
- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

9. I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

PRIVACY

10. I hereby consent to the collection of my personal information by the ST.
