The Stage is set for the final round of The **Honda RJays NSW Clubman Road Race Championship** at Eastern Creek on the 10 & 11th. The Point score at the top is tight and a few people could win outright, but the minor placings are still up for grabs.

The Points leader is **Paul Grant-Mitchell on 451 points** and he has provided an Official which boosts his points, while 2nd place Michael Burgess has 427 points, he hasn't provided an Official and this could be the difference in winning and coming 2nd or lower. In 3rd is a stalwart of the club, Pat James on 413 and he has provided an Official which helped after a crash in the 3rd leg of 400cc class and a DNS in leg 4 lost him lots of points.

The previous leader of the Championship Roland Kruck also had a crash in the wet Saturday Leg 2 race and did not start the other races and also did not compete in the 4 Hour Relay race so he dropped from 1st to 17th.

The weekend turned into a bit of a disaster for Roland after a win in the 1st leg.

In 4th place Maurice Nahlous is only 3 points behind Pat with 410 points and has provided an Official, so he definitely has a shot at the title. The top four represent B, A, C & D grade riders so every class is in with a chance to win. Phil Lovett is up the clackers of the top 4 with 398 points but has not

Mark Stevenson was the highest point scorer on Saturday's Rd 3 but ran 2nd in his class on Sunday and sits just behind Phil with 392 points after providing an Official. Only a few points behind Mark is Sophie Lovett and Angus Reekie so everybody wants to be on their A game this coming meeting or they could be overtaken easily.

For providing a Flag Marshall, riders receive 10 points, while if you provide an official for Scrutineering or catering you receive 5 points, with a maximum of 20 points each round so it could mean a total of 100 points over the season.

The Club Championship classes are also close and even though it's only a Trophy at the Presentation and Picnic Day, it's *The Club Championship*.
