Thank you for your entry to this road race meeting, it has been accepted. Below is additional information for this meeting:

- 1 TIME SCHEDULE:** Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2006 : Scrutineering: **2.00pm to 4.00pm**
- 1.1 Sunday, 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2006 Gates open 6.30am Scrutineering: 7.00am to 8.00am  
Officials Sign on: 7.45am Riders briefing 8.00am Warm Up: 9.00am. Racing: ASAP after Warm Ups.
- 2 FOR SCRUTINEERING** please bring your bike with the lower fairing removed for checking lock wire. Please wear your leathers, boots, helmet, gloves & back protector, also bring Senior **GREEN** National Licence. (NB **No PINK Clubman or One Day Licences**).
- 3 PRIVATE PRACTICE: Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2006.** Entry fee is \$130.00 if entered by Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October or \$150.00 on the day. Practice Entry form are available on our website [www.stgeorgemcc.com](http://www.stgeorgemcc.com) or phone me on (02) 9521 3715.
- 4 FUEL: IS NOT AVAILABLE** at the track.
- 5 GARAGES & CARPORTS:**
- 5.1 Garages are allocated by the Promoter. Your garage allocation is noted on Fax Back Form.
- 5.2 NOTE: there is no security overnight; anything left overnight is the responsibility of the Rider. Bring your own padlock to lock garage.
- 6 EVENTS:**
- 6.1 There will be 1 warm up lap per event, i.e. your sighting lap will be your warm up lap, to be confirmed by CofC on the day.
- 6.2 Riders going in the wrong Handicap race will be excluded from the results of the Handicap race they rode in.
- 7 DUMMY GRID:**
- 7.1 There will be a siren sounded for each event, one at two minutes & a second at 30 seconds before the pit gates will be opened.
- 7.2 The pit gates will be opened for a maximum of 20 seconds only to allow riders to enter the track for the next event.
- 7.3 Any rider still in the dummy grid after the pit gates are closed will commence the event from pit lane.
- 7.4 It's a rider's responsibility to know their grid position for each event. This will ensure your smooth transition through the dummy grid.
- 8 PIT LANE:**
- 8.1 No one without proper authority is allowed in pit lane. Only motorcycles, riders & mechanics from each team are permitted in pit lane.
- 8.2 Therefore a child under 16 yr. or deck chairs or BBQ's or baby strollers or playpens etc. are NOT permitted in Pit Lane areas.
- 8.3 Mechanical work on motor cycles is only permitted in pit lane or in the garages. No mechanical work is permitted on the Grid.
- 8.4 No open toed footwear may be worn in Pit Lane.
- 9 ENTRY PASSES:**
- 9.1 TICKETS ARE NOT ENCLOSED with these Final Instructions. They can be collected at Saturday Practice or at the gate on Sunday. DON'T LEAVE THEM AT HOME OR IN YOUR GARAGE AS YOU'LL HAVE TO PAY ADMISSION at the gate on Sunday morning.
- 9.2 Admission to the circuit is by entry pass only. Each rider will receive 2 passes. Additional passes can be purchased **BEFORE Thursday, 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2006** for \$15 ea, otherwise they are \$20 at the gate. Anyone 16 yr. or under will be admitted free.
- 10 ORDER OF EVENTS:** Due to entry numbers the following events will be combined & scored as one class:  
Twin 650's & Lightweight/Clubsport Lites
- 11. POINTSCORES & TROPHIES:**
- 11.1 Due to the number of entries in the following classes trophies will be awarded as:  
**Senior A&B 1<sup>st</sup> only.** **Unlimited A 1<sup>st</sup> only.**  
**400cc A 1st only.** **BEARs F3 & F4 – 1<sup>st</sup> only.**
- 12 ELECTRONIC TIMING WILL BE USED AT EVERY ROUND OF OUR SERIES:**
- 12.1. Transponders can ONLY be secured to your motorcycle using an AMB Transponder bracket. Brackets are available at Scrutineering for \$12.
- 12.2. Scrutineers will check placement of holders and there secure attachment of Transponder to your motorcycle.
- 12.3. Transponders are collected at Race Office; a Security Deposit of \$50 will be paid. The deposit will be returned at end of the meeting when the Transponder is returned in good working condition. **Please help us by having your cash or Bankcard details ready.**
- 12.4. The replacement cost of lost or damaged Transponders is the responsibility of the Competitor. NB this cost is \$580 each.
- 13. ROUND & SERIES PRIZES plus OFFICIALS POINTS:**
- 13.1 Please refer to Item 12 of Supplementary Regulations for details of Prizes & how they will be awarded.
- 13.2 For Round Prizes if a "Drawing from the Hat" is required for 5<sup>th</sup> place, as there are only 5 prizes, then the first name drawn from the hat receives the prize.
- 13.3 **Note to Top 20 Series Scorers to Date** – You must have provided an official at a minimum of 1 round to be eligible for Series Awards.
- 14. FLAG MARSHAL POINTS for SATURDAYS PRACTICE count towards Series Prizes:**
- 14.1 If you provide a Flag Marshal for the Saturday practice they will score 10pts as part of your Officials Series requirements per paragraph 12.2.6 to 8 of Series Rules.
- 14.2 Competitors can still only score 20pts from Officials by combining Saturday & Sunday Officials points. This will give Competitors more opportunities to provide a Flag Marshal at any round of the Series & also assist the Competitor to be eligible for Series Prizes.
- 14.3 Nominations for Saturday Flag Marshals can be made on the attached Fax back form or before 8.45am on Saturday Morning.
