SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. **ANNOUNCEMENT:** St. George MCC Inc., hereafter called the "Promoter", will conduct the Honda St. George Road Race Series for solo motorcycles at Wakefield Park Raceway Sunday 22nd April, 2007.

2. **JURISDICTION:** The above meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Ltd. (MNSW) who has issued the Motorcycling Australia (MA) Permit No. 07/17033 and is open to holders of current MA National Senior Competition Licences (i.e. No Club or One Day Licences) & 13to 15 year old competitors with Junior Licences endorsed for Road Racing .

2.1 The Meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS), these Supplementary Regulations, the Bylaws of MNSW and any Final Instructions. BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. **ENTRIES:** Entries open forthwith and close at midnight on 13/4//2007.

3.1 For inclusion in printed program, entries need to be received by 9/4/2007.

3.2 In case of postponement/abandonment of the meeting the Promoters may retain all or any part of the entry fee, if such retention is approved by MNSW.

3.3 Only entries received on the official entry form and accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

3.4 **Reserve Riders:** If an event is over subscribed then any entry received after the Grid is full will be a reserve entry. Unless the rider requests that his entry be withdrawn and entry fee refunded.

3.4.1 Reserve riders will be accepted into an event after another rider has confirmed with the C of C that he/she will not be competing in any further events on the day. The Reserve rider can then compete in the next heat for that event.

3.4.2 All Reserve Riders must ride in the Warm Up/Practice session to be eligible to race if a position becomes available.

3.4.3 If a reserve rider does not ride on the day then a full refund of his/her entry fee will be made within seven days of the event.

3.4.4 If a reserve rider gets to ride in only part of the heats then he/she may receive a pro rata refund of the entry fee based on the number of heats entered compared with total numbers of heats for that class.

3.4.5 Once a reserve rider's entry is accepted then no further refund of entry fee will be made should for some other reason he/she does not complete the remaining heats for that event.

3.5 Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Promoter.

3.6 RIDERS WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING will have entry fees refunded (less cost of track admission tickets if already mailed) if entry cancelled by 7pm on the Friday before the event.

4. **ENTRY FEE:** Early birds if paid by 9/04/2007 \$ 210
or after that if paid by 13/04/2007 \$ 235
2nd Machine/Class— Additional \$ 50
Entries paid by Credit Card will incur a fee of \$7.00.

Entry Fees INCLUDE GARAGE HIRE FEES

4.4.1 Payments by cash, cheque, money orders & credit cards are accepted (No Amex or Diners).

4.4.2 Any fees for dishonoured cheques or credit cards will be the responsibility of the entrant.

4.4.3 Cheques are payable to St. George MCC.

5. **ENTRY PASSES:** Each competitor will receive 2 entry passes. Additional passes can be purchased before the event for \$15ea (Limit 10 per competitor). Anyone over 16yrs without an entry pass will be charged \$20 at the gate.

6. **CLASSES OF COMPETITION:** The following events will be held over 5 heats. With the 4th heat being a combined scratch & handicap, with results published for first past the post & separately for Handicap result. All Events are included in Series point scores.

- 1) **Unlimited:** For 750-1300cc 2,3 & 4 cyls (No 250 GPs)
- 2) **400cc** For 400cc machines as per 400cc Series Rules.
- 3) **Senior:** Up to 700cc 4 cyl. & up to 750cc 2 & 3 cyls & 250 GPs.
- 4) **Bears** per Bears Rules. Scored by grade for HSTG Series. For Bears Club Championship scored by Formula 1–5.
- 5a) **GRO - Lites:** Up to 500cc - Female Competitors Only
- 5b) **GRO - Unlimited:** 500 to 1300cc – Female Competitors Only
- 6) **Clubsport Lites** Up to 160cc 2 stroke & 250cc 4 stroke road bikes, no buckets.
- 7) **Lightweight:** For 250cc (No 250GPs) & Single Cyl to 1300cc.
- 8) **650cc Twins:** For twin cylinder machines up to 650cc.
- 9) **Juniors 13-15 yrs.** For motorcycles between 80 & 150cc.

7. **TIMETABLE:** Meeting Starts / Gates Open: 6.50am
Scrutineering: Saturday 2.00 to 4.00pm Sunday 7.00am to 8.00am Officials Sign-on:
7.45am Riders briefing: 8.00am Practice: 9.00am Racing: ASAP after Practice ends.

8. **CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:** The events will be held on the 2.2kms hot mix bitumen circuit at Wakefield Park. The racing direction is clockwise.

9. RULES OF HANDICAP (Hcp) RACES

9.1 **Series Points:** The Hcp Race is included in HSTG Series point scores.

9.2 **Qualifying:** Time Handicap (THcp) is based on your fastest lap time from the first heat that you record a time in. If a rider enters two Classes then the THcp will be scored in both Classes & the worst result dropped from Series points.

9.3 **Handicapping:** THcp is based on the slowest lap time of all competitors multiplied by 5 laps for the Hcp event i.e. your THcp is the (difference between slowest lap time & your lap time) then that time is multiplied by 5 laps.

9.4 **Races:** THcp will be held within the classes of competition listed in paragraph 6 above. For example if you enter Class 5a then your handicap race will be with those bikes in that class.

9.5 **The Winner:** The competitor with the fastest THcp race time will be the winner of each Hcp race.

10. INSURANCE

10.1 National Capital Benefits Scheme, which provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

10.2 Personal Accident & Ambulance insurance is rider's responsibility.

11. **MEDICAL SERVICES:** Provided by Ambulance Australia. Being an FIV, Ambulance, 1 Paramedic and 2 Rescue Medical Technicians and shall be in attendance from 9am to 5pm on Sunday, 22nd April, 2007.

12. AWARDS & SERIES PRIZES:

12.1 **ROUND PRIZES:** At each Round of the Honda St George Road Race Series the following prizes will be awarded.

12.1.1 A competitor can only win one of each of the Round prize during 2007, i.e. during 2007 if you win the fabulous Round 1 Honda Product then you are ineligible to win another Honda Product during 2007 and so on to each prize. This rule is only applicable to Round Prizes & has no affect on the Series Prizes.

12.1.2 Round Prizes will be awarded using the same scoring method as the Series Point Score, but will be based on the points scored for the round only.

12.1.3 For Round Prizes Rule 12.2.6 does not apply in that you do not have to supply an Official to be eligible for a Round Prize, but Officials Points awarded as per Rule 12.2.7 will be included when determining a tie in the Round Prize winners. If a tie still remains then Series Rule 12.2.4 & 12.2.5 will apply.

12.2 **SERIES PRIZES:** The 2007 Honda St. George RR Series will award the following prizes, total value \$14,482. Round series prizes total \$3,200.

12.2.1 Prizes will be awarded based on points accumulated over four rounds, and will be awarded at the end of the fourth round.

12.2.2 Points will be awarded at each round on your place within your grade in each race run on the day, excluding Handicap Points which are base on THcp result. If due to lack of entries, grades are combined then the combined grades will be scored as one single event for this round. Series & class points & Trophies will be awarded as per finishing order for the combined grades.

12.2.3 Points in Series will be awarded to only one event including THcp per competitor on the day. If more than one event is entered by a competitor then the event scoring the highest points will be recorded in the Series results.

12.2.4 All scoring & points will be awarded as per MoMS. In the event of a points tie, MoMS 15.21.11.1 will apply. If this tiebreaker does not break the tie, FIM Road Racing World C'ship Grand Prix Regulation 1.28.7 will be applied.

12.2.5 In the event of a tie in the Series Pointscore that cannot be separated by the rules already included in the Supplementary Regulations then the awarding of prizes will be determined by a "Drawing from the Hat". The rules for the "Drawing from a Hat" are: the names of the tied competitors will be placed in a container, a name will be drawn by a party acceptable to the tied competitors & the first name drawn will choose their prize from the available prizes & so on until all tied competitors have received a prize or all prizes have been awarded.

12.2.6 Each competitor **MUST** supply at least ONE OFFICIAL at any one of the rounds & they must be nominated by 7pm Friday before round to be eligible for the Series Prizes. (N.B. You can ride all rounds without supplying an official but you will not be eligible to win series prizes).

12.2.7 **Points for Officials:** All Sunday officials & Saturday flaggies earn 10 Pts for their rider. Or 5 Pts if assisting with Catering or Scrutineering only.

12.2.8 A maximum of 2 officials per round count towards the Series prizes points score. (More officials are greatly appreciated but no extra points).

12.2.9 Each Competitor is responsible for their officials sign on before Saturday 8.20am & Sunday 7.45am and Officiate for the whole day to the satisfaction of the Chief Marshal.

12.2.10 For each flag Marshal will receive \$10 as a token of appreciation. If your Flag Marshal or Official is not needed you get the points, but no cash.

12.2.11 If a competitor changes bikes during the year series points still accrue.

12.2.12 If a competitor is re-graded during the year the series points still accrue.

The class points still accrue if the rider remains in the same class.

13. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

13.1 Ten entries are required to constitute a class.

13.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class, the decision to run, cancel, combine or separate classes will be at the discretion of the Promoter.

13.3 The promoter reserves the right of determining eligibility of any machine and to seed combination rider/machine into any event.

14. **RACE FORMAT:** for all events will be 5 Laps.

14.1 All Competitors will compete in at least five races with the 4th race being scored on a first past the post & separately on Handicap result.

15. **MACHINES & RIDERS:** All motorcycles, equipment & protective clothing must be scrutineered before practice & comply with Current MoMS.

16. **RIDING NUMBERS:** will be notified with final instructions.

16.1 Competitors will be allocated their MNSW registered riding number, or their preferred riding number, if entry is received by **early bird discount date**.

16.2 All numbers & plates on all machines must comply with the MoMS.

17. **GRID POSITIONS:** for heat 1 of each event will be from Qualifying.

17.1 Grids for each subsequent heat will be finishing order of the previous heat.

17.2 Any rider, for what ever reason, does not appear in the results of the previous heat will be graded at rear of grid for the next heat.

18. **RIDERS BRIEFING:** is Compulsory & will be held prior to the commencement of practice/racing & all competitors must attend.

18.1 Competitors must Sign On for Riders Briefing to confirm attendance.

18.2 Failure to attend Riders Briefing may result in a penalty up to exclusion from the meeting.

19. **DRUG and/or ALCOHOL TESTING:** As per MoMS.

20. **CODE OF CONDUCT:** As per MoMS.

21. **STARTS:** All races will be from a clutch start controlled by lights.

21.1 Your sighting lap will also be your warm-up lap.

22. **RACE FINISHES:** will be signalled by a waved chequered flag.

23. **NOISE:** All machines must comply with the requirements of the track licence being 95dba at 30 metres. You will be given one opportunity to correct the noise problem. A 2nd occurrence will result in exclusion from the meeting.

24. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

24.1 Machine impounding / Examination / Eligibility are at the discretion of the Steward/Clerk of Course.

24.2 TIMING results for races will only be published, No Practice Times.

24.3 Fuel is NOT available at Wakefield Park.

24.4 GARAGES and CARPORTS are available for the use of all competitors.

24.5 No person may wear open footwear in pit lane (MoMS 7.1.1.2 (2006)).

24.6 No non-competitor under 16 years of age may enter Pit Lane.

CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PRIVATE PRACTICE

WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.

1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below):

 HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

DEFINITIONS

2. In this declaration:
 - a) "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
 - b) "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
 - c) "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
 - d) "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
 - e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
 - f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

3. I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
 - a) motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
 - i) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - ii) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
 - iii) that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
 - iv) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
 - vi) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
 - vii) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - viii) that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
 - b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
 - c) to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
 - d) have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

4. Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:
 - rendered with due care and skill;
 - as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
 - reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.

For the purposes of the clause 3, "the Supplier" shall mean and include the Indemnitees.

INDEMNITY AND RELEASE GIVEN TO ORGANISERS

5. IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of me as a participant in the Meeting:
 - a) I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them in the following manner:
 - i) that I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
 - ii) that I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;

- iii) that I indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnitees, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions, costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.

- b) I AGREE TO RELEASE to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them from all liability to me for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, psychological trauma, death, property damage or infringement of third party rights or otherwise) that arises as a result of any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by me or which is in any way connected with my presence at or involvement in the Event.

6. The release and indemnity provided by me in this declaration is in addition to, and will not in any way limit the application of, the conditions of sale attaching to tickets, conditions of entry, conditions of credentials or any other applicable terms or conditions in respect of the Event.

7. A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

MEDICAL

8. I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Meeting. I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept the Indemnitees will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.

9. I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

PRIVACY

10. I hereby consent to the collection of my personal information by the ST.GEORGE MCC MA and the SCB in connection with my involvement at the Event and the use and disclosure of my personal information by ST. GEORGE MCC, and MA to other agencies and officials associated with the Event for the purposes of conducting and managing the Event. I understand that I may gain access to my personal information held by ST. GEORGE MCC by contacting ST. GEORGE MCC at PO BOX 124, SUTHERLAND NSW 1499 or MNSW at PO BOX 9172 Harris Park NSW 2150. I understand that if I do not provide the personal information requested above that I may not be permitted to participate in the Event.

POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

12. I acknowledge, understand and agree that it is a condition of my participation in the Event that I agree to be bound by, and subject to, the rules, regulations and jurisdiction of MA as amended from time to time. Copies of all MA rules, policies and regulations are available by contacting the MA office.

13. All participants are bound by the MA anti doping policy and thus understand they may be subject to drug testing. Testing conducted by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) is in accordance with the ASADA Act and the National Anti-Doping Scheme. This involves the taking of a sample (any human biological fluid or tissue whether alive or otherwise, or any human breath) for the purpose of detecting the use of a Prohibited Drug or Doping Method. Any participant infringing MA's policy or refusing a drug test may be disqualified or otherwise dealt with in accordance with the terms of the anti-doping policy.
