Thank you for your entry to this road race meeting, it has been accepted. Below is additional information for this meeting:

- 1 **TIME SCHEDULE: Saturday, 9th May, 2009** Gates open 6.30am Scrutineering: 7.00am to 8.00am
Officials Sign on: 8.00am **Riders briefing:** 8.15am **Qualifying:** 9.00am. **Racing:** ASAP after Qualifying.
- 2 **FOR SCRUTINEERING** please bring your bike with the lower faring removed for checking lock wire but **RADIATOR CAP must be off for checking that WATER ONLY is in the radiator.** Please wear your leathers, boots, helmet, gloves & back protector, plus your MA Licence & Club Affiliation Card for proof of membership in nominated club.
- 3 **GENERATORS:** Earlier this year there was an electricity problem to the garages. We've been told the problem has been fixed but we are moving on the caution side of things for this meeting. Therefore if you have a generator please bring it & use it for your tyre warmers. Also we have hired 2 generators for the use of all competitors; they'll be placed behind the garages. So if you wish to connect to one of these generators then please bring your own power board & long extension lead.
- 4 **FUEL:** IS AVAILABLE at the track.
- 5 **GARAGES & CARPORTS:**
 - 5.1 Garages are allocated by the Promoter. Your garage allocation is noted on Fax Back Form.
 - 5.2 JUNIORS - Please note that you are allocated Garages in Pit Lane (NOT on the Figure 8 Circuit).
- 6 **EVENTS:**
 - 6.1 There will be 1 warm up lap per event, i.e. your sighting lap will be your warm up lap, to be confirmed by CofC on the day.
 - 6.2 The handicap race will be in the 3rd Heat of Class Competition. I.e. the 3rd Heat will be a combined scratch & handicap event, with results published separately for first past the post & Handicap result. All Events are included in Series point scores.
 - 6.3 If you have entered more than one event is entered by a competitor then the event scoring the highest points will be recorded in the Series results. (refer Paragraph 12.2.3 of Supplementary Regulations).
- 7 **DUMMY GRID:**
 - 7.1 There will be a siren sounded for each event, one at two minutes & a second at 30 seconds before the pit gates will be opened.
 - 7.2 The pit gates will be opened for a maximum of 20 seconds only to allow riders to enter the track for the next event.
 - 7.3 Any rider still in the dummy grid after the pit gates are closed will commence the event from pit lane.
 - 7.4 It's a rider's responsibility to know their grid position for each event. This will ensure your smooth transition through the dummy grid.
- 8 **PIT LANE:**
 - 8.1 Only authorised personnel are allowed in pit lane, i.e. only Officials, Riders & Mechanics from each team are permitted in pit lane.
 - 8.2 Excluded from Pit Lane are: anyone under 16 yr.(that is not a competitor in this event), deck chairs, BBQ's, baby strollers, playpens etc.
 - 8.3 Mechanical work on motor cycles is only permitted in pit lane or in the garages. No mechanical work is permitted on the Grid.
 - 8.4 Fully enclosed footwear must be worn in Pit Lane.
- 9 **ENTRY PASSES:**
 - 9.1 TICKETS ARE ENCLOSED with these Final Instructions. DON'T LEAVE THEM AT HOME OR YOU'LL HAVE TO PAY ADMISSION at the gate on Saturday morning.
 - 9.2 Admission to the circuit is by entry pass only. Additional passes can be purchased **BEFORE Thursday, 7th May**, for \$15 each, otherwise they are \$20 at the gate. Anyone 16 yr. or under will be admitted free.
- 10 **POINTS SCORES & TROPHIES:**
 - 10.1 The following classes have been combined for pointscores & trophies: 1. Unlimited Clubsport & Unlimited Retro; 2. Unlimited V-Twin A,B C&D Grade, 3 Bears A & B Grade, 4 400cc Pro A&B, 5. 400cc Pro C&D, 6 400cc Stock A&B, 7 Juniors.
 - 10.2 To be eligible for Series Awards each competitor must provide at least one official at a minimum of 1 round during the Series.
 - 10.3 Series Prizes will be presented along with Club Championship Trophies at the Presentation Day in November, 2009.
- 11 **SCRUTINEERING CARDS:** can be collected from the Medical Centre when you sign on & collect your transponder.
- 12 **TRANSPONDERS FOR ELECTRONIC TIMING:**
 - 12.1 Transponders can ONLY be secured to your motorcycle using an AMB Transponder bracket.
 - 12.2 Scrutineers will check placement of holders and there secure attachment of Transponder to your motorcycle. If needed Transponder Brackets are available for \$12each.
 - 12.3 Transponders can be collected from the Medical Centre. A Security Deposit of \$50 will be collected & will be returned at the end of the meeting when the transponder is returned in good working condition. Please help us by having your cash or Bankcard details ready.
 - 12.4 The replacement cost of lost or damaged Transponders is the responsibility of the Competitor. NB this cost is at least \$580 each.
- 13 **FLAG MARSHAL POINTS**
 - 13.1 If you provide a Flag Marshal they will score 10pts as part of your Officials Series requirements per paragraph 6 to 8 of Series Rules.
 - 13.2 Competitors can score 20pts from Officials by combining Saturday & Sunday Officials points. This gives Competitors more opportunities to provide a Flag Marshal at any round of the Series & assist the Competitor to be eligible for Series Prizes.
 - 13.3 Nominations for Flag Marshals can be made on the attached Fax back form or before 8.00am on Saturday Morning.
