### Round 4, HONDA RJAYS ROAD RACE SERIES

Thank you for your entry to this road race meeting, it has been accepted. Below is additional information for this meeting:

- 1 **TIME SCHEDULE:** Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2009: Scrutineering: 2.00pm to 4.00pm
- 1.1 Sunday, 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2009. Gates open 6.30am Scrutineering: 7.00am to 8.00am  
Officials Sign on: 7.45am Riders briefing 8.00am Qualifying: 9.00am. Racing: ASAP after Qualifying.
- 2 **FOR SCRUTINEERING** please bring your bike with the lower fairing removed for checking lock wire but **RADIATOR CAP must be off for checking that WATER ONLY is in the radiator.** Please wear your leathers, boots, helmet, gloves & back protector, also bring Senior **GREEN** National, **PINK** Club or **One Event** Licence plus Club Affiliation Card for proof of membership in nominated clubs.
- 3 **PRIVATE PRACTICE: Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> October,** entry fee is \$140.00 if entered by Wednesday **21<sup>st</sup> October,** or \$160.00 on the day. Practice Entry form are available on our website [www.stgeorgemcc.com](http://www.stgeorgemcc.com) or phone me on (02) 9521 3715.
- 4 **FUEL:** Is not available at the track.
- 5 **GARAGES & CARPORTS:**
  - 5.1 Garages are allocated by the Promoter. Your garage allocation is noted on Fax Back Form.
  - 5.2 NOTE: there is no security overnight; anything left overnight is the responsibility of the Rider. Bring your own padlock to lock garage.
- 6 **EVENTS:**
  - 6.1 There will be 1 warm up lap per event, i.e. your sighting lap will be your warm up lap, to be confirmed by CofC on the day.
  - 6.2 The handicap race will be in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Heat of Class Competition. I.e. the 3<sup>rd</sup> Heat will be a combined scratch & handicap event, with results published separately for first past the post & Handicap result. All Events are included in Series point scores.
  - 6.3 For riders that have entered two events, your handicap result will be scored on the Class that you have nominated for Round & Series point scores (refer Paragraph 12.2.3 of Supplementary Regulations).
- 7 **DUMMY GRID:**
  - 7.1 There will be a siren sounded for each event, one at <sup>TWO</sup> minute & a second at 30 seconds before the pit gates will be opened.
  - 7.2 The pit gates will be opened for a maximum of 20 seconds only to allow riders to enter the track for the next event.
  - 7.3 Any rider still in the dummy grid after the pit gates are closed will commence the event from pit lane.
  - 7.4 It's a rider's responsibility to know their grid position for each event. This will ensure your smooth transition through the dummy grid.
- 8 **PIT LANE:**
  - 8.1 No one without proper authority is allowed in pit lane. Only motorcycles, riders & mechanics from each team are permitted in pit lane.
  - 8.2 Therefore a child under 16 yr. or deck chairs or BBQ's or baby strollers or playpens etc. are NOT permitted in Pit Lane areas.
  - 8.3 Mechanical work on motor cycles is only permitted in pit lane or in the garages. No mechanical work is permitted on the Grid.
  - 8.4 Fully enclosed footwear must be worn in Pit Lane.
- 9 **ENTRY PASSES:**
  - 9.1 TICKETS ARE **NOT** ENCLOSED with these Final Instructions. They can be collected at Saturday Practice or at the gate on Sunday. **DON'T LEAVE THEM AT HOME OR IN YOUR GARAGE AS YOU'LL HAVE TO PAY ADMISSION** at the gate on Sunday morning.
  - 9.2. Admission to the circuit is by entry pass only. Each rider will receive 2 passes. Additional passes can be purchased **BEFORE Thursday, 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2009** for \$15 ea, otherwise they are \$20 at the gate. Anyone 16 yr. or under will be admitted free.
- 10 **POINTS SCORES & TROPHIES:**
  - 10.1 The following classes have been combined for pointscores & trophies: 1. 600cc A&B Grade; 2. 250cc & Single Cylinder; 3. Unlimited Clubsport/Retro A-D Grade; 4. Unlimited V-Twin A-D Grade;
  - 10.2 **Note for Top 24 Series Scorers to Date** – You must have provided an official at a minimum of 1 round to be eligible for Series Awards.
  - 10.3 Round 4 Series Prizes will be presented along with Club Championship Trophies at the Presentation Day on Sunday, 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2009.
11. **TRANSPONDERS FOR ELECTRONIC TIMING:**
  - 11.2 Transponders can **ONLY** be secured to your motorcycle using an AMB Transponder bracket.
  - 11.3 Scrutineers will check placement of holders and there secure attachment of Transponder to your motorcycle. If needed Transponder Brackets are available for \$12each.
  - 11.4 Transponders are collected at Medical Centre but returned to Race Office at end of meeting, a Security Deposit of \$50 will be paid. The deposit will be returned at the end of the meeting when the transponder is returned in good working condition. **Please help us by having your cash or Bankcard details ready.**
  - 11.5 The replacement cost of lost or damaged Transponders is the responsibility of the Competitor. NB this cost is \$655 each.
12. **FLAG MARSHAL POINTS for SATURDAYS PRACTICE count towards Series Prizes:**
  - 12.1 If you provide a Flag Marshal for the Saturday practice they will score 10pts as part of your Officials Series requirements per paragraph 12 of Series Rules.
  - 12.2 Competitors can score 20pts from Officials by combining Saturday & Sunday Officials points. This gives Competitors more opportunities to provide a Flag Marshal at any round of the Series & assist the Competitor to be eligible for Series Prizes.
  - 12.4 Nominations for Saturday Flag Marshals can be made on the attached Fax back form or before 8.45am on Saturday Morning.
