Thank you for your entry to this road race meeting, it has been accepted. This meeting also incorporates a Bears National Round and Round 2 of the Sava Tyres Bucket National.

- 1 **TIME SCHEDULE:** **Gates open** 6.30am **Sign On: 6.45am** **Scrutineering:**7.00am to 8.00am
Officials Sign on: 8.00am **Riders briefing** 8.30am **Practice & Qualifying:** 9.00am.
Racing: ASAP after Qualifying.

2 SCRUTINEERING

- 2.1 Please bring your bike with the lower fairing removed for checking lock wire, and the RADIATOR CAP must be off for checking that WATER ONLY is in the radiator.
- 2.2 **Please wear your leathers, boots, & back protector plus bring helmet & gloves.**
- 2.3 Bring MA Licence plus Club Affiliation Card for proof of membership in nominated clubs.
- 2.4 Motor Cycle No's. The rule for this meeting is that numbers must be clearly readable at 235kmh, front numbers if number plate area is not flat must be placed towards the Riders **left** on the **North & GP Circuit, and riders Right for the South Circuit** (when seated on motor cycle) of the front fairing. numbers will be checked at Scrutineering & any number deemed not to comply with rule will need to be fixed before being passed at Scrutineering.

2.5 **Special Note for Competitors in Clubsport Events: Please ensure you know where your compliance plate and VIN number are situated on your machine when scrutineer inspects your machine/s.**

- 3 **FUEL:** Is not available at the track.

4 GARAGES & CARPORTS:

- 4.1 Garages are allocated by the Promoter. Garage allocation is on your Fax Back Form & final list will be posted on St George Website on Tuesday 4th November, 2014.
- 4.2 NOTE: there is no security overnight; anything left overnight is the responsibility of the Rider. Bring your own padlock to lock garage.
There are no garages available on the South Circuit. Refer to Additional Instructions for South Circuit for details.

5 EVENTS:

- 5.1 There will be 1 warm up lap per event, i.e. your sighting lap will be your warm up lap, to be confirmed by Clerk of Course on the day.
- 5.2 The handicap race will be in the 2nd Heat of Class Competition. I.e. the 2nd Heat will be a combined scratch & handicap event, with results published separately for first past the post & Handicap result. All Events are included in Series point scores.
- 5.3 For riders that have entered two events, your handicap result will be scored on the Class that you have nominated for Round & Series point scores (refer Paragraph 10.2.3 of Supplementary Regulations).

- 5.4 **Competitors MUST NOT EXIT at TURN 4 on North & GP circuits until chequered flag is shown.**

6 DUMMY GRID:

- 6.1 There will be a siren sounded for each event, one at two minutes & a second at 30 seconds before the pit gates will be opened.
- 6.2 The pit gates will be opened for a maximum of 20 seconds only to allow riders to enter the track for the next event.
- 6.3 Any rider still in the dummy grid after the pit gates are closed will commence the event from pit lane.
- 6.4 It's a rider's responsibility to know their grid position for each event. This will ensure your smooth transition through the dummy grid.

7 PIT LANE:

- 7.1 No one without proper authority is allowed in pit lane. Only motorcycles, riders & mechanics from each team are permitted in pit lane.
- 7.2 Therefore a child under 16 yr. or deck chairs or BBQ's or baby strollers or playpens etc. are NOT permitted in Pit Lane areas.
- 7.3 Mechanical work on motor cycles is only permitted in pit lane or in the garages. No mechanical work is permitted on the Grid.
- 7.4 Fully enclosed footwear must be worn in Pit Lane.

8 ENTRY TICKETS:

- 8.1 TICKETS ARE ENCLOSED with these Final Instructions. **DON'T LEAVE THEM AT HOME OR YOU'LL HAVE TO PAY ADMISSION** at the gate on arrival.
- 8.2 Admission to the circuit is by entry pass only. Each rider will receive 3 passes. Additional passes can be purchased **BEFORE Thursday, 6th November, 2014** for \$15 ea, otherwise they are \$20 per day at the gate. Anyone 16 yr. or under will be admitted free.
- 9 POINTSCORES & TROPHIES:**
- 9.1 Details of Classes to be combined for point scores, Trophy & Awards Presentation will be notified on the St George Website on Tuesday 4th November, 2014 & at Riders Briefing.
- 9.2 To be eligible for Series Awards each competitor must have provided at least one official at a minimum of 1 round during the Series.**
- 10 TRANSPONDERS FOR ELECTRONIC TIMING:**
- 10.1 **North & GP Circuits:** Transponders are collected from Arthur Blizzard Stewards Room and must be returned to Race Secretary's Office at end of meeting.
South Circuit: Transponders are collected from Race Secretary's South Circuit Office and must be returned to Race Secretary's South Circuit Office at the end of the DAY(except for those few competitors who are continuing to race Sunday on the GP Circuit).
- You will be required to sign a hiring agreement and leave your Competition Licence as holding deposit for each unit.**
- If the transponder is damaged during the meeting or if the unit is not returned at the conclusion of the meeting you could have a problem going home without your licence plus receive an account for the cost of the transponder. If you don't have a Full competition licence you are required to pay the normal \$50.00 holding deposit for each unit.**
- 10.2 Transponders must ONLY be secured to your motorcycle using an AMB Transponder bracket.
- 10.3 Scrutineers will check placement of holders and the secure attachment of Transponder to your motorcycle. If needed Transponder Brackets are available for \$15 each.
- 10.4 The replacement cost of lost or damaged Transponders is the responsibility of the Competitor. NB this cost is \$655 each.

SPECIAL NOTES:

- 1. After unloading, ALL TRAILERS MUST be moved to Trailer Parking area behind the ARDC Office Building. If you do not move your trailer from Pit Area – ARDC Security will tow the vehicle away.**
- 2. PRIVATE PRACTICE IS AVAILABLE ON FRIDAY 7th NOVEMBER.** If ARDC get 10 prepaid bike bookings for that day a session will be set up for motorcycles. Phone ARDC (02) 9672 1000 for bookings.
- 3. Friday 7th November:** During the hours 5.30-9.00pm Friday, ARDC are allowing interstate riders, who may have an overnight security problem with their trailers, to unhook and leave trailers in garages that will be locked overnight. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES must machines be started during this time.**
