1 TIME SCHEDULE: Saturday:

Gates open: 7.00am Scrutineering: 7.00am to 8.30am (no scrutineering during Riders Briefing)

Officials Sign on: 7.30am. Riders briefing 8.00am Practice & Qualifying 9.00am.

Racing: ASAP after Qualifying.

Sunday: Riders Briefing: 8.00 am. Warm Up: 9.00am Racing: ASAP after Warm Up.

2 SCRUTINEERING

- 2.1 Scrutineering Cards can be collected at Race Secretary's Office when Signing On & collecting Transponder before getting your motor cycle & gear scrutineered.
- 2.2 Please bring your bike with the lower fairing removed for checking lock wire, but the RADIATOR CAP must be off for checking that WATER ONLY is in the radiator.
- 2.3 Please wear your leathers, boots, & back protector plus bring helmet & gloves.
- 2.4 Bring Senior Licence plus Club Affiliation Card for proof of membership in nominated clubs.
- 2.5 Motor Cycle No's. The rule for this meeting is that numbers must be clearly readable at 235kmh, front numbers if number plate area is not flat must be placed towards the Riders left (when seated on motor cycle) of the front fairing. No's will be checked at Scrutineering & any No. deemed not to comply with rule will need to be fixed before being passed at Scrutineering.

2.6 All Clubsport and Retro entries will have their compliance plate checked to ensure they comply with class rules. Riders are to ensure their compliance plates are visible at scrutineering and will be disqualified if they do not comply.

3 FUEL: Is not available at the track.

4 GARAGES:

- 4.1 Garages are allocated by the Promoter. Allocation is on your Fax Back Form & final list will be posted on St George Website on Wednesday 8th June, 2016.
- 4.2 NOTE: there is no security overnight; anything left overnight is the responsibility of the Rider.

5 EVENTS:

- 5.1 There will be 1 warm up lap per event, i.e. your sighting lap will be your warm up lap, to be confirmed by Clerk of Course on the day.
- 5.2 The handicap race will be in the 2nd Heat of Class Competition. I.e. the 2nd Heat will be a combined scratch & handicap event, with results published separately for first past the post & Handicap result. All Events are included in Series point scores.
- 5.3 For riders that have entered two events, your handicap result will be scored on the Class that you have nominated for Round & Series point scores (refer Paragraph 9.4 of Supplementary Regulations).

6 DUMMY GRID:

- 6.1 There will be a siren sounded for each event, one at two minutes & a second at 30 seconds before the pit gates will be opened.
- 6.2 The pit gates will be opened for a maximum of 20 seconds only to allow riders to enter the track for the next event.
- 6.3 Any rider still in the dummy grid after the pit gates are closed will commence the event from pit lane.
- 6.4 It's a rider's responsibility to know their grid position for each event. This will ensure your smooth transition through the dummy grid.

7 PIT LANE:

- 7.1 No one without proper authority is allowed in pit lane. Only motorcycles, riders & mechanics from each team are permitted in pit lane.
- 7.2 Therefore a child under 16 yr. or deck chairs or BBQ's or baby strollers or playpens etc. are NOT permitted in Pit Lane areas.
- 7.3 Mechanical work on motor cycles is only permitted in pit lane or in the garages. No mechanical work is permitted on the Grid.

7.4 Fully enclosed footwear must be worn in Pit Lane.

8 ENTRY PASSES:

8.1 No admission tickets required for this meeting.

9 **RIDING NUMBERS:** Are as per the attached "Fax Back" Form. PLEASE ENSURE YOUR RIDING NUMBERS ARE CLEAR AND EASY TO READ.

10 POINTSCORES & TROPHIES:

Details of Classes to be combined for point scores, Trophy & Awards Presentation will be notified on the St George Website on Wednesday 8th June & at Riders Briefing.

10.2 To be eligible for Series Awards each competitor must provide at least one official at a minimum of 1 round during the Series.

11 Overall Series Prizes will be presented along with Club Championship Trophies at the Presentation Day which is being held at Gynea Sports & Bowling Club on date to be notified.

12 TRANSPONDERS FOR ELECTRONIC TIMING:

Transponders are collected from Race Secretary's Office and must be returned to SAME PLACE at the end of the meeting. These units cost just under \$650.00 each. A special bracket, which holds the transponder, will also be available for a cost of \$15. **You will be required to sign a hiring agreement and leave your Competition Licence as holding deposit for each unit.**

If the transponder is damaged during the meeting or if the unit is not returned at the conclusion of the meeting you could have a problem going home without your licence plus receive an account for the cost of the transponder. If you don't have a full competition licence you are required to pay the normal \$50.00 holding deposit for each unit.

Please make sure that you have plenty of cable ties with you so that the unit can be attached securely to your machine.

13. SPECIAL NOTES:

1. Because of the holiday weekend we have Monday to return home. Therefore there will be a trophy presentation at conclusion of this meeting.

2. **Photo/film Footage is not to be uploaded or shared on any social media until you have left the track. Riders are also responsible for the actions of their family, crew, friends etc. in this regard.**
