These Final Instructions must be read in conjunction with the Supplementary Regulations for the meeting. PLEASE STUDY ALL THE ENCLOSED INFORMATION VERY CAREFULLY:-

Gates Open: 6.50am

1. ADMISSION PASSES: Tickets ARE NOT required for this meeting

2. RIDING NUMBERS: Your riding number for the meeting is as per the attached Acceptance Form

Please study this form carefully **and if there is anything that you feel is incorrect please 'FAX BACK' the form advising the incorrect details and any licence details required.** If the problem can be fixed prior to arriving at the circuit it will be sure to save a lot of time.

<p><u>3. CHAMPIONSHIPS:</u> There were only enough entries received in 5 classes to constitute championships There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd trophies for all classes where there is more than 4 entries plus an Encouragement award.</p>
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<p>Due to lack of entries Bears event is being run conjointly with Unlimited Clubsport.</p>

<p>Also Production 300 & Production have also been combined to form a Championship class and now renamed "Modern Senior Championship for machines up to 500cc.</p>
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4. PIT AREA – GARAGES

Your allocated garage number is printed at the bottom of Fax Back Form. Please remember to bring your own PADLOCK AND KEY if you wish to lock your garage overnight. However, please note that anything left overnight is the responsibility of the rider.

5. SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering Saturday commences at 7.00am..

Please ensure that you have everything with you including your Scrutineering Card.

LEATHERS MUST BE WORN TO SCRUTINEERING.

YOUR SCRUTINEERING CARD IS NOT ENCLOSED WITH THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

IT IS AN MA REQUIREMENT THAT ALL COMPETITORS AND OFFICIALS SIGN ON. PLEASE SEE RACE SECRETARY ON ARRIVAL TO SIGN ON AND FINALISE YOUR ENTRY (where necessary) AND COLLECT YOUR SCRUTINEERING CARD BEFORE GOING TO SCRUTINEERING.

7. QUALIFYING TIME IS VERY LIMITED and will be conducted as per the attached "Programme of Events". It will be in your own best interests to be ready on time and waiting in the dummy grid area.

8. ELECTRONIC AMB TRANSPONDER TIMING: You are required to fit a transponder to all machines entered for the meeting. A special bracket, which holds the transponder, will also be available for a cost of \$15.

These transponders cost just over \$655.00 each. **You will be required to sign a hiring agreement and LEAVE YOUR COMPETITION LICENCE AS A holding deposit for each unit. If the transponder is damaged during the meeting or if the unit is not returned at the conclusion of the meeting you will receive an account for the cost of the transponder.**

Please make sure that you have plenty of cable ties with you so that the unit can be attached securely to your machine/s.

9. RIDERS' BRIEFING: commences **8.00am Saturday and Sunday and is compulsory. Every rider must attend and sign on in person.** Non attendance WILL result in a monetary fine of \$200.00 and/or exclusion from the meeting.

10. FUEL is NOT AVAILABLE at the circuit.

11. FUEL TESTING: Competitors are advised that random fuel testing may be carried out during the meeting.

12. DUMMY GRID:

- i) There will be two sirens sounded for each event, first will be two minutes followed again at 30 seconds before the pit gates will be opened.
- ii) The pit gates will be opened for a maximum of 20 seconds only to allow riders to enter the track for the next event.
- iii) Any rider still in the dummy grid after the pit gates are closed will commence the event from pit lane.
- iv) It's a rider's responsibility to know their grid position for each event. This will ensure your smooth transition through the dummy grid.

13. PIT LANE:

- i) No one without proper authority is allowed in pit lane.
- ii) Children under 16 yrs (unless a competitor) deck chairs, BBQ's, baby strollers or playpens will not be permitted in Pit Lane areas.
- iii) Only motorcycles, riders & mechanics from each team are permitted in pit lane.
- iv) Mechanical work on motor cycles is only permitted in pit lane or in the garages. No mechanical work is permitted on the Grid.
- v) Fully enclosed footwear must be worn in Pit Lane.
- vi) No person is allowed on Pit Wall at any time. Signalling will be allowed from designated area only.

14. GRID POSITIONS:

For Leg 1 of each class will be from qualifying. Grids for 2nd, 3rd, 4th, & 5th leg of any event will be the finishing order from the previous leg of that event. Any rider, for whatever reason, does not appear in the results of the previous leg will be grided at rear of grid for the next leg.

15. TROPHY PRESENTATION :

Trophy presentation will take place at the conclusion of racing on Sunday evening. The State Championship trophies will be presented later in the year at the Night of Champions.

16. SPECIAL NOTE:

- 1) **Friday 2nd September, 2016. Private practice is available on this day. Contact Wakefield Park Management direct for information.**
- 2) Another quick reminder that no BBQ's and/or anything with naked flame permitted in pits and/or garages.
