

The following notes are to advise you of some important points pertaining to this meeting. ### **TIME SCHEDULE**

**Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August** **Bump-in Note** There is an event being staged at the venue on Friday evening. To avoid being charged an entry fee, upon arrival at the circuit you must advise the Security team that you are attending the weekend St. George motorcycle racing event.

### **Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> August**

Scrutineering after the riders briefing in the grey scrutineering shed	8.00am onwards
On Track next event in Schedule commences	8.30am
Presentation of Trophies 20 minutes after last Event Back of Garage 21&22	

### **RIDER SIGN-ON**

Riders are required to sign on using QR code placed in their garages.

MA requires all sidecar competitors to sign on using both the QR code and the MA hard copy forms.

### **FUEL**

98 RON fuel is available at the circuit. Refer to <http://www.ardc.com.au/fuel/> for details.

### **GARAGES**

Garages are allocated by the Promoter. There is no overnight security, therefore, anything left overnight is the responsibility of the rider. We suggest that you bring your own padlock to lock your garage.

Please note – throughout the weekend you should secure all valuables to prevent theft.

### **Technical Inspection**

At technical inspection all participants will be required to place a 2025 NSW Road Race Championships logo (sticker) as supplied by the technical inspector on the front number plate of your bike/sidecar as directed. Sidecars will also be required to place the MA logo (Supplied by the technical inspector) on their front number plate.

### **Practice Starts**

Practice starts are only permitted after practice in the designated area past turn 15 on **Saturday ONLY**.

The practice start area will be defined by a sign and orange cones and will be riders right after turn 15. All riders to use caution and riders not performing a practice start are to proceed past the area on riders left using caution.

### **RACE STARTS**

Race starts will be via the Starter's gantry red lights. Should the lights fail, the races will be started by the raising of the National Flag. Please refer to the Supplementary Regulations for a full description of this starting method.

### **PINK VESTS**

The St. George Motorcycle Club or Clerk of Course may mandate that some competitors wear the pink-coloured vest.

The coloured vest will be supplied by the Race Secretary and will be signed out when issued. The vest must be returned with the competitor's transponder.

Competitors supplied with a coloured vest who enter the track at any time without the vest being worn will be shown the black flag. The Clerk of Course may also apply a penalty, which may result in the rider's exclusion from the Event without a refund.

### **THIS APPLIES TO ALL TRACK ACTIVITY, INCLUDING PRACTICE, QUALIFYING AND RACING.**

Competitors should exercise caution when overtaking any rider wearing a pink vest.

### **ELECTRONIC AMB TRANSPONDER TIMING AND ARDC MYLAPS GPS TRANSPONDERS**

The red AMB and black MyLaps transponders are to be collected from the Race Secretary, located in Garages 21 and 22.

The MyLaps transponder needs to be returned at the end of each day for battery charging.

### **CRASHES**

If you crash and are taken to hospital or are recommended by the medical team to seek further medical treatment, your licence will be automatically suspended.

To return to racing you will need to submit to Motorcycling NSW a written clearance from the hospital or a Doctor stating that **"you are able to commence motorcycling activity"**.

- If you crash you MUST attend the medical centre and be assessed by the medical team. They will then notify the Clerk of Course whether you have been cleared to resume racing or not.
- If possible, move your bike to the tyre wall and get yourself to a safe area behind the wall or to a flag marshal post.
- Do not remove your helmet until you are safely behind a barrier.
- If you abandon your machine and walk away, do not return to your machine.
- If able, please help the recovery crew load your machine onto the trailer.

### **MECHANICAL BREAKDOWNS**

- If possible, move your bike to the tyre wall and get yourself to a safe area behind the wall or to a flag marshal post.
- Do not remove your helmet until you are safely behind a barrier.
- If you abandon your machine and walk away, do not return to your machine.
- Please help the recovery crew load your machine onto the trailer.
